4 SEC. 6033. (a) The Secretary of the Interior shall allow
5 the State of Mississippi, its lessees, contractors, and permit-
6 tees, to conduct, under reasonable regulation not incon-
7 sistent with timely and generally full extraction of the oil
8 and gas minerals:

9 (1) exploration, development and production op-
10 erations on sites outside the boundaries of Gulf Is-
11 lands National Seashore that use directional drilling
12 techniques which result in the drill hole crossing into
13 the Gulf Islands National Seashore and passing under
14 any land or water the surface of which is owned by
15 the United States, including terminating in bottom
16 hole locations thereunder; ~~or~~ **AND**
seismic-related

17 (2) seismic and exploration activities inside the
18 boundaries of Gulf Islands National Seashore related
19 to extraction of the oil and gas located within the
20 boundaries of the Gulf Islands National Seashore, all
21 of which oil and gas is owned by the State of Mis-
22 sissippi.

23 (b) The provisions of subsection (a) shall not take effect
24 until the State of Mississippi enters into an agreement with
25 the Secretary providing that any actions by the United
26 States in relation to the provisions in this section shall not
